

ANNUAL MEETING—1941

At the conclusion of the formal business at the meeting on 29 March, under the chairmanship of Sir James Berry, in the absence of the President, a paper was read upon the muniments belonging to Shardeloes, by kind permission of our member, Capt. T. Tyrwhitt-Drake.
