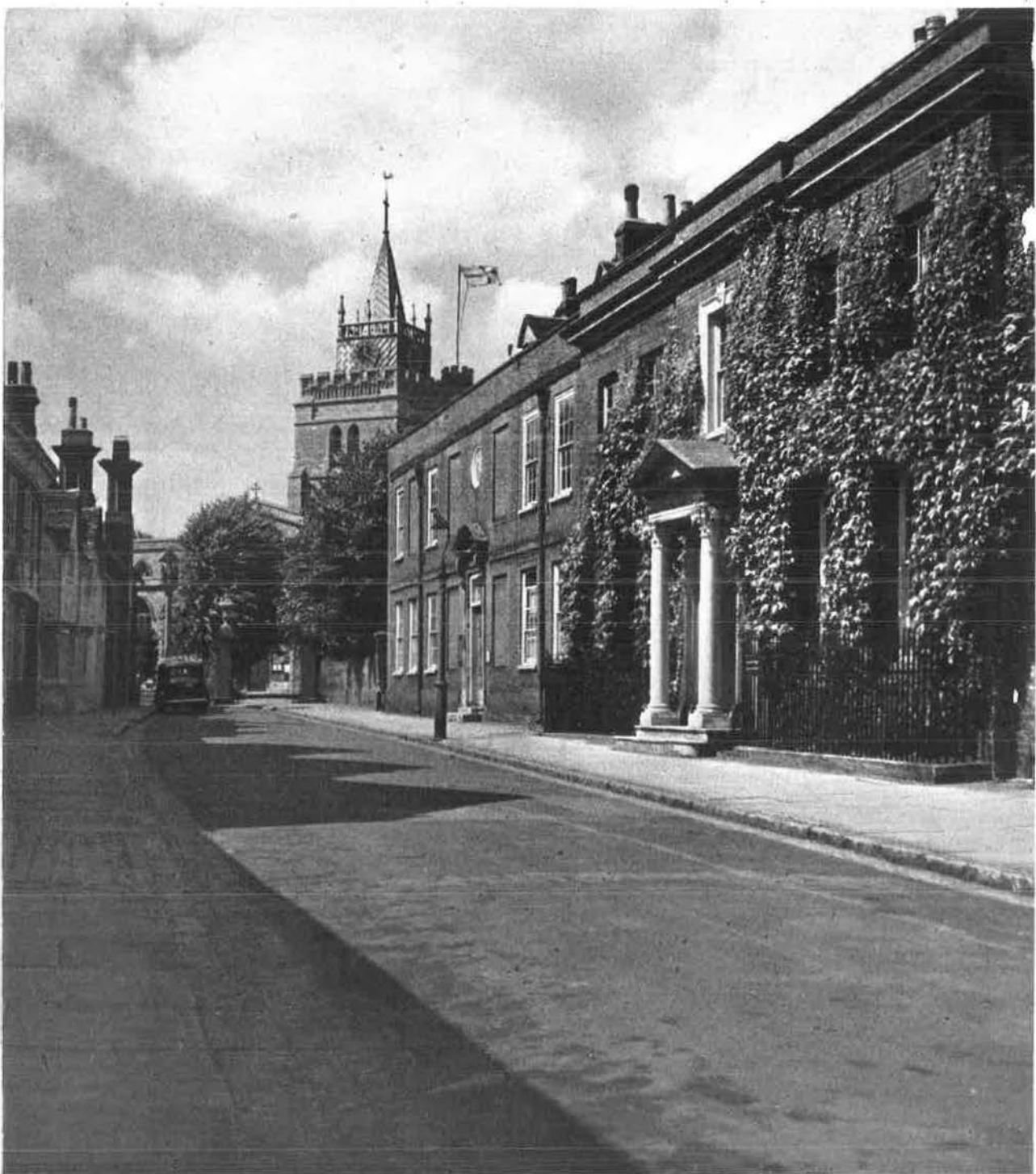


PLATE 1. THE MUSEUM AND CEELY HOUSE, CHURCH STREET, AYLESBURY
